

Re: Marine Air Terminal, LaGuardia Airport Security Zone Enforcement - Temporary Bowery Bay, Queens, New York Closure


1. In accordance with regulations contained in 33 CFR 165, the Coast Guard will be enforcing a security zone in Bowery Bay, Queens, New York, in the vicinity of LaGuardia Airport, as outlined in the table below. No vessel transits will be permitted within the security zone while it is in effect. Changes in the time that the security zone is in effect may occur. In the event additional waterways need to be closed under urgent conditions, or changes occur to the security zone, immediate notice will be made to mariners via safety marine information broadcast over VHF-FM Channel 16 and the Homeport Alert Warning System. VTS participants will also receive notice via VHF-FM Channel 12 and 14. If unable to reach the Command Vessel contact VTSNY on VHF-FM channel 12 or at (718) 354-4088 for updates.

- 2. The security zone includes all waters of Bowery Bay, Queens, New York, inside of a line drawn from the start of the Rikers Island Bridge in Queens at approximate position 40°46′37″ N, 073°53′30″ W to the intersecting point on the southern side of Rikers Island at approximate position 40°47′12″ N, 073°53′06″ W, then a line drawn east to the western end of LaGuardia Airport at approximate position 40°47′00″ N, 073°52′44″ W, then a line drawn south following the shoreline back to the point of origin at 40°46′37″ N, 073°53′30″ W (NAD 1983). - 4. The Coast Guard is establishing an additional security zone in all waters of Bowery and Flushing Bays within approximately 200 yards of La Guardia Airport. See page 3 for visual depiction of security zone.
- 5. Scheduled and unscheduled broadcasts will be made notifying the maritime community when the security zone is established.
- 6. Violation of a Security Zone can result in civil penalties up to \$117,608 per violation and/or other enforcement actions as per 46 U.S.C. 70036(a).
